OUTDOOR LEARNING

P6 Pupils report on our recent 2 day visit from Ardroy Outdoor Learning: On Thursday 29th April the Ardroy Outdoor Learning people came to teach us survival skills. We went down to the shore and we made a delicious pizza that we cooked over a fire. We then filtered water through a filter that we made by ourselves.

We also made a shelter out of a tarpaulin, two hiking sticks and some rocks that we gathered from the shore. While we were waiting for the pizza to cook we played a very fun game called camouflage. To make the fire we chopped up wood using knives that Alex and Cake brought with them.



On Friday 30th we went rock climbing up the rocky hill behind the school. Alex and Cake from the Ardroy Outdoor Learning helped us with this climbing. I did not feel scared doing this climbing as I do it a lot at home. We stopped on a grassy path with lots of flowers and trees. We got to try some wild food such as mint, primrose, violet and wood wort. We started to use a saw to cut down some branches to make a shelter, we gathered sticks, moss and bracken. We finished the shelter and we all managed to squeeze in to take a photo. We started to walk to a little gate which led us up to a cliff with rugged terrain.



Our P6 pupils report:

On Friday 7th May the geography teacher from Tobermory High School called Miss Campbell came to do shore school with us and teach us about how the island was formed. It was very fun and I enjoyed learning about all the different types of rocks that make up Mull. There is basalt and granite rocks which are igneous, this means they are formed by heat. There was some sandstone, which is sedimentary.

On Wednesday 12th May it was a rainy afternoon, Marion the Buddy Trainer came to our school. We P6's are already buddies however the P5's were going to be trained.
